



Solicitation Policy

The Barbados Hash House Harriers (BH3) is a non-registered group that organizes runs on Saturdays and on Bank Holidays. It is over 30 years old. It is run by non-remunerated volunteers, organizes volunteers to set runs, and refreshments after the runs. Cash funds are collected and banked, refreshments are paid for, required equipment purchased, and if surplus funds are accumulated they are either donated to charitable causes or used to fund events that benefit the BH3 members.

The fact that there may be sometimes in excess 150 'hashers' running at an event has led in recent times to private hash members and their companies to solicit hashers to events, trips and profit making enterprises that result in profit taking by these persons/companies. BH3 is a non-profit group and seeks to regularize/regulate how and when such approaches occur, as the dynamic between profit making and BH3 are not necessarily aligned.

All events and their solicitations in and around BH3 are to be proposed in writing to the "Mis-management" Committee for consideration and/or approval. This submission must be made in advance of their launch and/or announcement, or the announcement of the intent to create an event. The BH3 consists of the BH3 Whatsapp chat and/or chats that purport to represent BH3, the BH3 Facebook pages, the Bh3 website www.barbadoshash.com; and physically at the BH3 Saturday and Bank Holiday runs.

Proposals are required to be submitted to committee@barbadoshash.com via email, and proposer(s) must await approval and/or authorization by the committee before announcing or creating an event that is to be marketed within or around BH3, its media and/or events.
